**James Robey** is a dance artist, teaching artist and scholar who holds BFA in Dance from the University of Akron and MFA in Dance from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee where he graduated Phi Kappa Phi. James is the founding Artistic Director of *James Robey Dance*, a member of the Dance History Scholars, International Association of Dance Medicine, National Dance Education Organization, on the Advisory Board of the Connecticut Dance Alliance on Connecticut Ballet's Danbury Dance Initiative Task Force, and is author and creator of the James Robey Jazz Dance Technique. Robey has been on the faculty of the Hartt School of Music/University of Hartford, and has performed for the Metropolitan Opera Ballet Company, Connecticut Ballet, New York Dance Theater, and Cleveland Opera. Robey teaches master classes across the U.S. as well as internationally.
